#### **BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS**

Effective September 18, 2002: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC; 2) The individual handling the dog in the Bred-By Class must be a breeder of record and a current owner of record of the dog; 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog.

#### **EXIBITORS - PLEASE NOTE**

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these events. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry form that accompanies this Show Premium List.

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the clubs nor show secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class being judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog(s) in the judging ring.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge; or barred from competition by the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete because it is incorrectly entered.

**NO FAX ENTRIES.** Any overnight private carriers requiring a signature upon delivery will not be guaranteed to be received in time to meet required deadline for closing.

**No** entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. **Entries must be on Official AKC Entry Forms**. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic mail, prior to the close of entries. Entries received by telephone are not acceptable.
