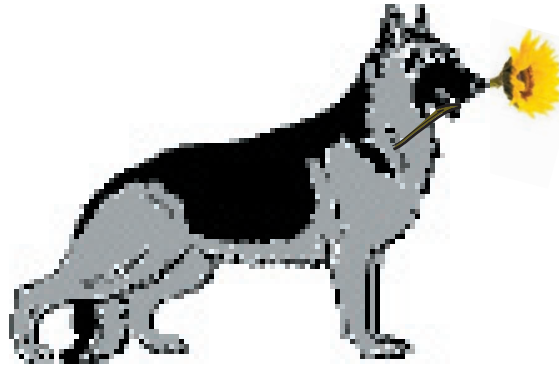
- vii. Other New Business:

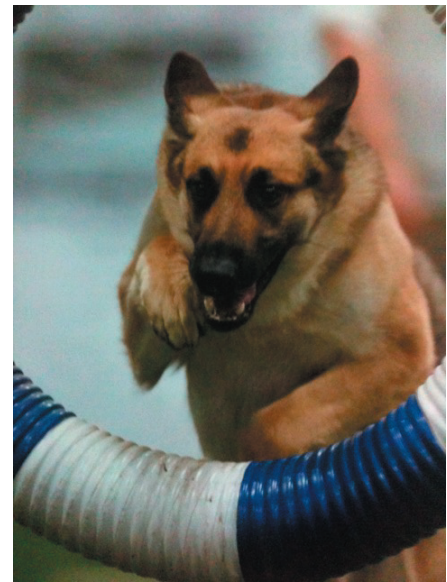

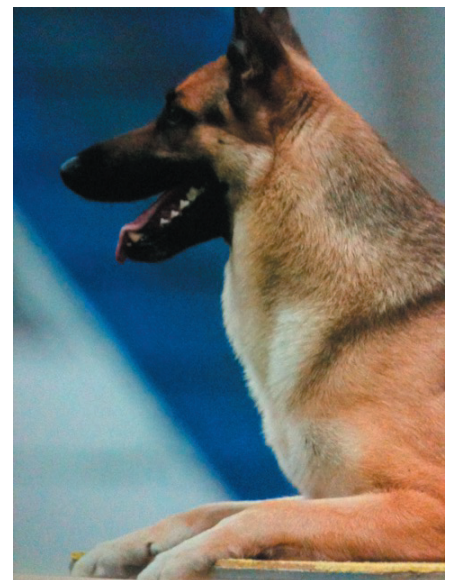
