Following the Specialty show the next activity was the June Ron Halling Workshop which moved outside for the summer. It is held at the Veteran's Park in Apple Valley next to the VFW. The purpose of the workshop is "to strengthen trust, your bond and communication, increase focus motivation and confidence with your dog...all while having fun socializing with your pointy-eared (and human) friends." I borrowed that statement from the e-mail sent out this month. I attended the morning session and took pictures which you will find on pages 2 and 3. The afternoon session included more advanced work on stopping chasing and working with tunnels. This is an opportunity for great training tips. The next training session is July 16 at the same location. Prices are as follows: \$30.00 (cash) for either the morning or afternoon session. In order to attend the afternoon session, you must have attended a morning session at some time prior (that morning counts). You may have heard of the group walks. If you attend one of these trainings, you and your dog will be eligible to participate in the group walks.

RON HALLING WORKSHOP WITH GSDCMSP



The mini session will began at 9:15 and went too 9:50 (prior to joining the group for the 10 am lecture). It is designed to help dogs who may not be quite ready to move into a class setting, and is for dogs super shy to super aggressive and everything in between.

Morning session offered how to raise a GSD” by GSD experts. We also do problem solving with any and all issues. It began with the lecture at 10:00 am, followed by the hands on session at 11:00 am where the training techniques talked about in the lecture were employed and participants practiced how to communicate with their dog through the “marker system” , using positive and negative feedback to mark desired and non desired behaviors.



Time for morning lecture



Eye exercises, focusing on the face or hand.



A nice sit.



Working in a large circle which gradually tightened up, the dogs learned to concentrate while working around other dogs, healing, sitting, and going over low jumps.



The dogs formed two lines facing each other and then moved in toward a center line where they performed the sit, down, and eye exercises working on impulse control while gradually approaching the dogs in the opposite line



The afternoon session included what to do about chasing behavior and practice with tunnels.

All awards must be documented with a copy of the Issuance of Title / Title Certificate from the AKC, GSDCA, GSDCA-Working Dogs or / Face page of GSDCA publication and Copy of "Review" page listing said title or certification. If your dog has earned an AKC/AKC recognized title and/or your club has participated in an event/activity not listed above, please write in the title/event, provide proof, and if approved, points for that title or club participation will be awarded accordingly. [Note: The first page of this form MUST be completed for EACH dog. You need only print/submit those subsequent pages containing particular titles for your dog. A separate form must be included for each club's collective/group contributions with the name of your Regional Club Challenge Representative.]

Remember the first page of this form MUST be completed for EACH individual dog, and only one form may be submitted for each dog. (Entries submitted without this form properly completed will not be counted.) You need only print and submit those subsequent pages containing the particular titles for this dog, and all multiple titles for this dog should be indicated on this form. If requesting points for collective/group club awards or events, you may submit one Regional Club Challenge Award Form as a summary. In fact, a separate form should be

We've made some changes to our structure over the last year that seem to help a lot more people get enjoyment and results for what we do. The Mini-session is for dogs that may not be quite ready to move right into a class setting will be a staple as we move on. (Our cost)

The 11 am Hands-on training. Here, we employ the training techniques talked about in the lecture while teaching you to communicate with your dog. We teach you the "marker" system that through demonstrated performance has proven to be one of the best training techniques for our highly intelligent breed. You'll leave feeling confident you know how to raise your pup through it's imprinting stages and in doing so have a GSD that people admire.

12ish, lunch. Due to COVID we are not able to do our Potluck lunches. If staying for the day you can purchase lunch from the American Legion and enjoy your meal under the roof of the picnic area on one of the many tables.

The 12:30 Afternoon Activity Class is different each month and is well thought out to present owners with activities functional to our breed according to the seasons. this month we'll focus on: heeling techniques while out meeting and greeting strange dogs and humans. This includes dogs that lunge and carry on when seeing another dog as well as building your shy or nervous dog's confidence. We'll be teaching you how to utilize dominance over obedience to overcome territorial issues and meeting/living with other animals.

Group Walk-usually a week later we'll blind copy the attendees on our email list the time and location of our Group Walk. These fortify what you have learned and while walking you see your dog meld into that day's "pack". If you peek at our webpage you'll see FOX did a news story with 38 GSD's that showed up. We also had a special walk with 55 dogs. The walk however is restricted to those that have attended a morning session. This is so everyone is familiar with the techniques needed to have a trouble free walk. Prices remain the same, 30.00, (cash), for either the morning or afternoon session, (must have attended a morning session prior to the Afternoon Activity class). It's an extra 15.00 to bring a second dog from your household or to stay for the afternoon session after attending the morning session. High temperatures can make the asphalt too hot for your dog's paws!


| Air temperature | Asphalt temperature |

Provided no objections have been filed within 30 days of publication in the Review, applicant will be notified that he/she is eligible for all privileges including the right to vote. **Junior Members:** Must be 10 years of age and not more than 18 years of age and shall subscribe to the same criteria as Regular Membership with the exception of the requirement to pay dues. Junior members cannot vote, hold office, or serve on committees other than Junior committees.
